Notice of application for consent in pursuance of Schedule 10

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with Schedule 10 of the Water Resources Act 1991, as amended by the Environment Act 1995, that an application has been made to the Environment Agency by Anglian Water Services Limited for consent to discharge sewage effluent. The application is for a consent to discharge up to a maximum of 6,840 cubic metres per day of sewage in an emergency from King's Lynn Treatment Works, Clenchwarton, Norfolk, into the Tidal River Great Ouse at National Grid Reference TF60542222, the dry weather flow in the sewer being 21,600 cubic metres per day.

The application is for a discharge in the event of mechanical or electrical failure to prevent flooding of the site, from the refurbished King's Lynn Sewage Treatment Works. Frequency of operation is not likely to be more than once per ten years.

King's Lynn Sewage Treatment Works is within the Borough of King's Lynn & West Norfolk and Norfolk County Council areas.

The recognised uses of the Tidal River Great Ouse include basic amenity, habitats for aquatic life, a migratory fish route and commercial shellfisheries.
