TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping-up of a part of the southern footway of Marylebone Road, London N.W.1.

If the Order is made, the stopping-up will be authorised only in order to enable the development described in the Schedule to this notice to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted under Part III of the Act to Lee Evans de Moubray by the City of Westminster on 8th November 1995 under reference PE/TP/4403.
