### HIGHWAYS AGENCY

#### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

##### *The A64 Road (Tadcaster-Bilbrough) (Prohibition of Various Traffic Movements) Order*

The Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under sections 1(1) and 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the A64 Trunk Road in the district of Selby in the County of North Yorkshire

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit

- (a) any vehicle from making a U-turn through the gap in the central reservation opposite the junction of the A64 with Redhill Field Lane, or opposite Robinsons Colton, Steeton House Farm, Streehouses or Bowbridge Farm,
- (b) any vehicle from making a U-turn from the A64 eastbound carriageway to the westbound carriage through the gap in the central reservation opposite Bilbrough Lodge or Stceton Grange,
- (c) any vehicle from making a U-turn from the A64 westbound carriageway to the eastbound carriageway through the gap in the central reservation opposite the Aagrah Restaurant, or opposite the junction with Colton Lane or Slice Lane,
- (d) any vehicle when entering the A64 from the Aagrah Restaurant to proceed in any direction other than westwards, or
- (e) any vehicle which has an operating weight exceeding 7.5 tonnes, when entering the A64 from Colton Lane, to proceed in any direction other than westwards

Exemptions will be provided for emergency services vehicles

This Order may be cited as the Specified Risk Material Order 1997 and shall come into force on 1st January 1998

This Order revokes the Specified Bovine Materials Order 1997 and the Heads of Sheep and Goats Order 1996. This Order re-makes with amendments the provisions of those Orders prohibiting the use of specified bovine material in feeding stuffs and cosmetic, pharmaceutical and medical products. The controls on the use of specified bovine material in food, and the provisions relating to the removal of specified bovine material from cattle and its destruction are now contained in the Specified Risk Material Regulations 1997

The Order imposes controls on the import of class 1 specified risk material (defined in article 2 by reference to the definitions of specified bovine material and specified sheep and goat material set out in articles 3 and 4) and requires imported food and feedingstuffs of the types set out in Schedule 1 to be certified by the veterinary authorities in the place from which they were despatched to the UK as not containing class 1 specified risk material (article 6)

- He proposes to modify the conditions of the Licence granted to The National Grid Company plc (hereafter referred to as "NGC") under section 6(1)(b) of the Act by amending Condition 4A (Restrictions on revenue) and Schedule 3 (Supplementary provisions of the charge restriction conditions).
- He proposes these modifications to bring into effect new arrangements for NGC in relation to transmission services uplift and reactive power uplift following the consultation paper issued by the Director in December 1997.
- The effect of the modifications is to introduce revised incentives on NGC in relation to transmission services uplift for a two year period commencing on 1 April 1998, with a revised default arrangement for a third year to apply in the absence of a new agreement at that time. The effect of the modifications is also to introduce revised incentives on NGC in relation to reactive power uplift for a one year period commencing on 1 April 1998, with a revised default arrangement for a second year to apply in the absence of a new agreement at that time.
