ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The London Borough of Tower Hamlets (Red Route) (No 2) Experimental Traffic Order 1998

Notice is hereby given that the London Borough of Tower Hamlets in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, on 13th March 1998 made the above-mentioned Order, which comes into force on 23rd March 1998 and can remain in force for up to 18 months.

The general nature and effect of the Order will be to introduce new Red Route controls along Burdett Road between its junction with Commercial Road/East India Dock Road and Mile End Road. Lengths of side roads immediately adjacent to this route and listed in the Schedule to this notice are also included

The new controls will include:

Double red line controls prohibiting stopping at any time at locations where stationary vehicles cause danger or congestion at any time,

Single red line controls prohibiting stopping between the hours of 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. Monday to Friday,

Boxes marked on the carriageway where demand exists for loading/unloading and parking at locations where stationary vehicles do not cause congestion or danger,

Exemptions to the new Red Route controls will be few but do allow for boarding and alighting from buses, taxis and disabled passengers from disabled persons vehicles.

The Order provides that in pursuance of section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Service Head—Street Services or some person authorised in that behalf by him, if it appears to him, or that person, essential in the interests of expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by the Order runs, modify or suspend the Order or any provision thereof.

A copy of the Order, which will come into force on 23rd March 1998, the Borough's statement of reasons for making the Order and a plan showing details of the scheme can be inspected during normal office hours on Monday to Friday inclusive until the expiration of a period of 6 months from that date at the offices of Customer Services, Council Offices, Southern Grove, London E3 4PN
