#### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

*The A487 Trunk Road (High Street, Porthmadog, Gwynedd)  
(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 199*

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales proposes to make an Order under sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the proposed Order will be to prohibit all vehicles from stopping in those lengths of the A487 Fishguard-Bangor Trunk Road (hereinafter referred to as "the trunk road") specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

- (i) the eastern side of that length of the trunk road which extends from a point 12 metres south of the centre-point of its junction with Glaslyn Street to a point 16 metres north of the centre-point of that junction;
- (ii) the western side of that length of the trunk road which extends from the centre-point of its junction with Railway Place in a southerly direction for a distance of 23 metres. (490)
