### CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

#### NOTICE OF SEIZURE OF GOODS PERSON OR PERSONS UNKNOWN

The Commissioners of Customs and Excise give you notice:

The revised comprehensive Double Taxation Convention between the U.K. and the Kingdom of Lesotho, which was signed in London on 29th January 1997, entered into force on 23rd December 1997.
