TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Stopping up of Highways (Brewery Place Wrexham) Order 1998

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 to authorise the stopping up of the length of highway described in the Schedule 1 to this notice

If the Order is made the stopping up will be authorised only in order to enable the development described in Schedule 2 to this notice to be carried out in accordance with planning permissions granted by Wrexham County Borough Council on 9th June 1997 under Ref WRO CB00976 and on 1st July 1997 under Ref WRO CB00975. The proposed Order shall cease to have effect upon the cessation of the planning permission.

During the 28 days from 10th July 1998 copies of the draft Order and the deposited plan may be inspected free of charge during normal office hours at the offices of Wrexham County Borough Council Planning Department Lambpit Street Wrexham or may be obtained free of charge from the address below quoting the Welsh Office reference.

Within the above mentioned period of 28 days any person may by notice to the Welsh Office Highways Directorate Cathays Park Cardiff CF1 3NQ (quoting Ref ZC 501 5 16 1) object to the

making of the Order. In the preparation of an objection it should be borne in mind that the substance of any objection or representation may be communicated to other people who may be affected by it.

SCHEDULE 1

All distances are approximate.

The highway to be stopped up is at Wrexham in the County Borough of Wrexham and comprises

- (i) that length of Brewery Place which extends from the western boundary of the BRSA Club in a north westerly direction for a distance of 25 metres and
- (ii) a triangular shaped area of footway adjoining the south westerly corner of the BRSA Club building 6 metres in length and having a maximum width of 3 metres

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The A487 Frank Road (Dublin Street Tremadog, Gwynedd) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1998
