The Secretary of State for the Environment Transport and the Regions hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 247 of the above Act entitled *The Stopping up of Highways (County of Derbyshire) (No 5) Order 1998* authorising the stopping up of a length of highway at Marston Lane Hatton Derbyshire from a point 55 metres east of the junction with Station Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 333 metres.
