#### Queen's Commendation for Bravery

Jeffery Christopher Love Constable Warwickshire Constabulary

For assisting in the rescue of a hostage during an armed siege Police were called to a house following an attack on the two female occupants by two suspects armed with a pair of scissors and a knife A member of the public was alerted by one of the women after she had managed to escape and he went to give assistance. As he entered the house he was taken hostage at knife point forced to sit in a chair and had lighter fluid poured over him.

Constable Love arrived and entered the house In order to try to gain the release of the hostage he started to talk with the suspects who had barricaded themselves in the lounge. One suspect then ordered Constable Love to remove his radio baton and other equipment and to enter the lounge. He decided to do this but as he entered he was searched and then made to take off all his upper clothing his boots and other personal possessions which were thrown onto the fire

The suspects then threatened to kill Constable Love and the other hostage unless one of the women returned and spoke to them As she

spoke to the suspect from outside the lounge Constable Love saw an opportunity and overpowered one of the suspects. At the same time police officers forced their way into the lounge and arrested the other suspect.
