TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Stopping-up of Highways (Park Street, Cardiff) Order 1998

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 to authorise the stopping-up of highway described in the Schedule 1 to this Notice

The stopping-up is authorised only in order to enable the development described in Schedule 2 to this notice to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted by Cardiff County Council on 24th February 1998 under Ref 96/01911/C The Order shall cease to have effect upon the cessation of the planning permission

If any person desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any of the provisions contained therein, on the grounds

- (a) that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, or
- (b) that his interests have been substantially prejudiced by a failure to comply with any of the requirements of the Act,

he may, within 6 weeks of 17th August 1998, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein

All distances are approximate

The highway to be stopped up is at Cardiff in the County of Cardiff and comprises a 105 metre length of Park Street (including footways) which is of irregular shape, having a maximum width of 22 metres and a total area of 1,200 square metres, and extends from its western most extremity in a north-easterly direction towards its junction with Scott Road for a distance of 105 metres
