TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Stopping-up of Highways (Templar's Avenue, Wrexham)
Order 1998

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 to authorise the stopping-up of the length of highway described in Schedule 1 to this notice

If the Order is made, the stopping-up will be authorised only in order to enable the development described in Schedule 2 to this notice to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted by Wrexham County Borough Council on 1st April 1998 under code number WRC CB01761 The proposed Order shall cease to have effect upon the cessation of the planning permission

During the 28 days from 26th October 1998, copies of the draft Order and the deposited plan may be inspected, free of charge, during normal office hours at Wrexham County Borough Council, Planning Department, Lammpit Street, Wrexham, or may be obtained, free of charge, from the address below quoting the Welsh Office Reference
