ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

*The A483 Trunk Road (Four Crosses, Welshpool, Powys)
(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1998*

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Wales has made an Order under section 1, 2, 4 and 124 of, and paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit all vehicles from stopping in the length of the A483 Swansea-Manchester Trunk Road (hereinafter referred to as "the trunk road") specified in the Schedule to this notice

During a period of 6 weeks from 30th October 1998, a copy of the Order, together with a plan may be inspected, free of charge, during normal office hours at the offices of Powys County Council, Severn Road, Welshpool

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order, or any provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that his or her interests have been substantially prejudiced by a failure to comply with any of the requirements of the Act, he may, within 6 weeks from 30th October 1998, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order, or any provision contained therein
