*The Stopping-up of Highways (Albion Street, Pillgwenlly,
Newport) Order 199*

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, to authorise the stopping-up of the area of highway described in the Schedule to this notice

If the Order is made, the stopping-up will be authorised only in order to enable development at land at Albion Street, Pillgwenlly, Newport, consisting of the construction of 20 No houses with associated roads to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted on 22nd July 1998, under Ref No 98/0534/F. The Order will cease to have effect upon the cessation of the planning permission

The Order will also require the provision of new highways, as described in the Schedule to this notice, which will be highways maintainable at public expense, for which the County Borough of Newport shall be the Highway Authority

During the 28 days from 27th November 1998, copies of the draft Order and the deposited plan may be inspected, free of charge, during normal office hours at The Civic Centre, Newport NP9 4UR, or may be obtained, free of charge, from the address below, quoting the Welsh Office reference below

Within the above-mentioned period of 28 days any person may, by notice to the Welsh Office Highways Directorate, Roads Administration Division 3, Crown Buildings, Cathays Park, Cardiff CF1 3NQ, (quoting Ref ZC510-5-34-5) object to the making of this Order. SCHEDULE

All distances are approximate

Description of the highway to be stopped up under this Order

The highway to be stopped up is part of Albion Street, Pillgwenlly, Newport, and comprises an area of the footway and carriageway at the eastern end of Albion Street, which commences from its junction with Commercial Road in a generally westerly direction for 102 metres and a maximum width of 11 metres

The highways to be provided are at Albion Street, Pillgwenlly, Newport, and comprise —

- (i) a 129 metre length of carriageway and footway commencing on Temple Street from a point 30 metres west of its junction with Commercial Road, generally proceeding in a northerly direction for 75 metres and then in a westerly direction for 38 metres and in an easterly direction for 16 metres
- (ii) a 48 metre length of footpath running alongside the rear of numbers 22-27 Temple Street in a generally easterly direction and then in a northerly direction from a point opposite number 27 Temple Street, and
- (iii) a 24 metre length of footpath commencing from the junction of Albion Street and Commercial Road in a westerly direction
