#### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

#### THE RUSHDEN (NO. 5) (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACE) VARIATION ORDER 1998

Notice is hereby given that on 22nd December 1998 East Northamptonshire District Council made the above-mentioned Orders under section 32 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act). The Orders will restrict the use of the off-street parking areas in Rushden between Duck Street and John Street, in Newton Road and John Street to the motor vehicles as set out in the Schedule to this notice.

The Orders will come into operation on 5th January 1999 and copies of the Orders, together with location maps indicating the effect of the Orders and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the Orders are available for inspection at The Rushden Centre, Newton Road, Rushden, Northamptonshire NN10 0PT, during normal office hours

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Act or that a requirement of the Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Orders were made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
