EDEN DISTRICT COUNCIL (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 1999

PROPOSED OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES ORDER

Notice is hereby given that Eden District Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, to control the use of the parking places named in Schedule 1 to this notice, which also shows the maximum period for waiting and the scale of charges proposed for each parking place. The proposed charges to be made in Zones A, B and C and the hours to which these charges relate are shown in Schedule 2 to this notice.

The cost of a season ticket for any parking place where applicable will be £52 00 for 12 months and £30 00 for 6 months.

The Excess Charge for contravention of provisions contained in the Order will be £50 00, but the Council will accept the reduced sum of £20 00 if payment is made within 14 days of the contravention.

The Order subject to paragraph 7 below will come into effect on 1st July 1999 and will be cited as the Eden District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1999.

The Order will specify the conditions under which the parking place may be used. Full details are contained in the draft Order which together with a map showing the location of the parking place, may be seen at the Town Hall, Penrith, Cumbria, Monday to Friday, 9 a m to 4 45 p m. The Order will revoke the Penrith (Parking Places) Order 1966, insofar as it relates to the car parks specified by name in the Schedule to this

notice, and as varied by The Penrith Parking Place (Variation and Amending) Orders 1967, 1970, 1971, 1974, 1974 No 2, 1976, 1979 and 1980 and the Eden District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Orders 1986, 1987, 1988, 1989, 1990, 1991, 1992, 1993 and 1993 (No 2). The registered driver of a disabled person's vehicle as operated under the Orange Badge Scheme will be exempt from any limitation of time and from any payments.

If anyone wishes to object to this Order, the objection, with the grounds of making it should be made in writing to the undersigned not later than 19th April 1999.
