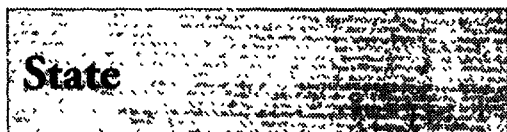

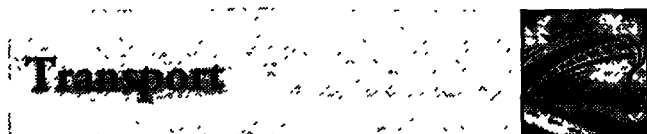

PROPOSED TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT MEASURES IN ASSOCIATION WITH TRAMLINK

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Croydon propose to make the Croydon (Goods Vehicles) (Free Parking Places) (No. 2) 1991 (Amendment No. M22) Order 1999, the Croydon (Prescribed Routes) (No. M20) Order 1999 and the Croydon (Central) (Parking Places) (No. 1) Order 1993 (Amendment No. M21) Order 1999 under the relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985.

The general effect of the Croydon (Goods Vehicles) (Free Parking Places) Order would be:

- (a) to designate a free parking place in Church Street, (the north-east to south-west arm) on the north-west side, from a point 10 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Reeves Corner north-eastward for a distance of 20 metres, and having a width throughout of 2.70 metres;
- (b) to provide that the parking place would be in operation between the hours of 7 a.m. and 7 p.m., on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive;
- (c) to specify that the use of the parking place would be restricted to goods vehicles only for the purpose of loading or unloading goods or delivering or collecting goods from premises in the vicinity of the parking place;
- (d) to restrict to 30 minutes any one period of waiting in the parking place and to prohibit the return to the same parking place of the same vehicle for a period of one hour;
- (e) to provide that the parking place may be suspended when necessary to facilitate the carrying out of certain functions such as building or street works, furniture removals, funerals etc.

(f) the restrictions on the use of the parking place will not apply to certain vehicles viz., to police, fire brigade and ambulance vehicles, to broken down vehicles and those being used in connection with building and street works or for the collection or delivery of postal packets etc.

The general effect of the Croydon (Prescribed Routes) Order would be:

- (a) to revoke and re-enact the one-way working from south to north in Cairo New Road to exclude an exemption for pedal cyclists;
- (b) the prohibition would not apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or anything done in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway by or on behalf of the Metropolitan Police.

The general effect of the Croydon (Central) (Parking Places) Order would be to revoke 2 hour "pay and display" parking bays in Old Palace Road to facilitate the provision of a goods vehicle loading bay and in George Street and Church Street to allow for the passage of trams along the tram route.

The revocation and re-enactment of the one-way working in Cairo New Road is to exclude an exemption for pedal cyclists to allow

for the safe movement of trams, cyclists being provided for by the implementation of segregated cycle lanes.

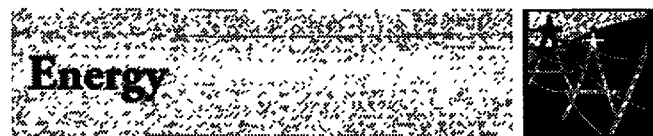

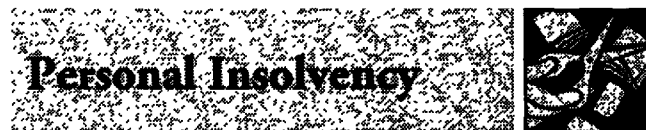

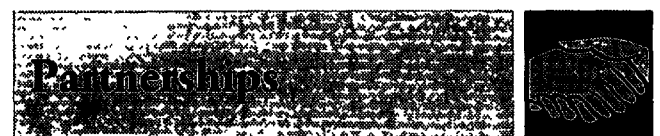
