**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984** 

THE A6 TRUNK ROAD (NEWTOWN, NORTH) (40 MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 199

The Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions gives notice that he intends to make an Order under sections 84(1)(a) and (2) of, and paragraph 27(1) of, Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Order, if made as proposed, will impose a 40 miles per hour speed limit on the A6 trunk road, Buxton Road, Newtown, from a point 125 metres west of the junction with Peveril Gardens, to a point 221 metres east of the junction with Lower Greenshall Lane, a distance of approximately 555 metres

Existing Orders imposing a 40 miles per hour speed limit will be amended to exclude the lengths of road in the proposed Order
