THE A41 TRUNK ROAD (TONG) SHROPSHIRE (DERESTRICTION) ORDER 1999

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet have made on Tuesday, 26th October 1999, an Order under sections 45, 46, 49 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The general nature and effect of the Order will be to provide parking bays for doctors in roads specified in the Schedule to this notice.

THE BRENT (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO.) ORDER 1999

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Brent propose to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985.

The general effect of the Order would be further to amend the Brent (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1979, so that:

- (a) the hours during which the existing prohibition applies on waiting by vehicles would be changed so that such prohibition would apply at any time in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 1 to this notice;
- (b) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place would be changed so that such prohibition would apply

between 11 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. throughout the week in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 1 to this notice;

(c) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be prohibited at any time in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 2 to this notice;

(d) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be prohibited between 8 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 3 to this notice;

(e) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be prohibited between 8 a.m. to 9.30 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. to 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 4 to this notice;

(f) the hours during which the existing prohibition applies on waiting by vehicles would be changed so that such prohibition would apply between 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the length of street specified in Schedule 5 to this notice;

(g) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place would now be prohibited between 11 a.m. and 6.30 p.m.:

(i) throughout the week in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 2 to this notice;

(ii) on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 3 to this notice;

(h) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place would now be prohibited between 4.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in lengths of streets specified in Schedule 4 to this notice;

(i) the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle would be prohibited (except on Sundays in the lengths of streets specified in Schedules 3 and 4) unless there is in force a valid licence issued by the Brent Borough Council or the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected;

(j) the use of the vehicle or of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume, wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising would be prohibited;

(k) any existing prohibition on the waiting by vehicles, the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle or the use of any vehicle or animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising in the lengths of street specified in Schedule 6 to this notice would be revoked.

The prohibitions referred to in sub-paragraph 2(a) to 2(h) inclusive above would not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in certain circumstances, e.g., the picking up or setting down of passengers; the carrying out of statutory powers or duties; the taking in of petrol, etc., from roadside petrol stations; to licensed street traders, etc. The usual exemption relating to vehicles displaying a disabled person's "Orange Badge" would apply.

A copy of the proposed Order, of maps of the relevant areas, of the Brent (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1979, (and of the Orders which have amended that Order) and of the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the expiration of a period of 21 days from the date on which this notice is published at:

Bridgewater Road, the north-east side, from 10 metres south-east of the access road leading to One Tree Hill Clinic to Nos. 2/4 Bridgewater Road.

East Lane:

(a) the north-east side, from Nos. 110-112 East Lane to Nos. 223-225 and 227-229 East Lane;

(b) the south-west side, from Nos. 213-215 East Lane to Nos. 223-225 and 227-229 East Lane.
