THE JADE FIELD

Pursuant to Regulation 5(8) of the above Regulations, the Secretary of State for Trade and Industry gives notice that, being content that the requirements of the above Regulations have been satisfied, he has, pursuant to Licence P 672, granted a consent to Phillips Petroleum Company UK Ltd, to the getting of petroleum and the construction of installations in relation to the development of the Jade gas/liquid phase field. The consent for the Jade field took effect from 4th January 2000, and shall last until 31st December 2006.

The Jade development lies in Block 30/2c, 270 kilometres from the UK coast and 15 kilometres from the UK/Norway median line, in the Central North Sea.

Phillips propose to develop the Jade reservoir to commence production in 2001. The development will involve the completion of well 30/2c-4 and the drilling of up to four additional wells. Water based mud will be used for the top sections of all wells, and low toxicity oil-based muds (LTOBMs), for the lower sections. Disposal of LTOBMs will be either by annular reinjection or by transportation to shore. There will be no extended well testing. The Jade platform will be a normally unattended installation tied back to the Judy platform via a 16", 17 kilometre pipeline. Produced gas will be exported to Teesside through the CATS system, via the existing Judy connecting pipeline.

The Secretary of State is of the view, having regard to the environmental statement prepared in respect of the project and the comments received from those consulted, that the project is not likely to have significant effects on the environment and that adequate mitigation of the potential environmental impacts, such as they are, is presented in the environmental statement. SMOKE CONTROL AREA

The whole of the London Borough of Camden was subject to Smoke Control Orders made under Clean Air Acts in the 1950s and 1960s. There have been boundary changes which have brought new areas into the borough, which are not subject to Smoke Control Orders. The Council wishes to subject these areas to Smoke Control Orders.

The Council of the London Borough of Camden proposes to revoke all existing Smoke Control Orders (see list below), pursuant to section 18 of the Clean Air Act 1993, and to make a new Smoke Control Order covering the whole of the area of the borough. This, like the existing Orders, will make it an offence to emit smoke from any chimney in the borough, subject to some exceptions. *It will make it an offence, for example, to emit smoke from burning ordinary coal or wood on an open fireplace.* This will have no new effect on the vast majority of properties unaffected by the boundary change and will only apply these new controls to properties becoming part of Camden as a result of the boundary changes.

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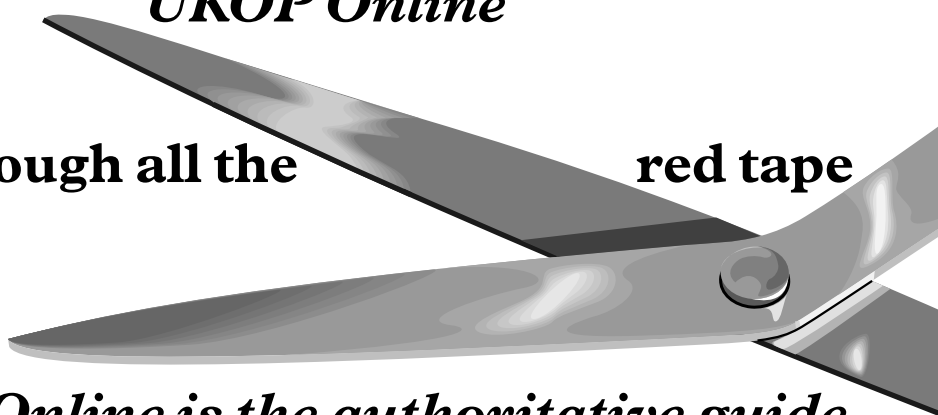
