ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE HASTINGS BOROUGH COUNCIL (CORNWALLIS STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2000

Notice is hereby given that, on 27th April 2000, Hastings Borough Council made an Order, under sections 32, 33, 35 and 39 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), the effect of which will be

The Hastings Borough Council (Cornwallis Street Parking Place) Order 1976 shall be amended in these terms:

- (1) A designated season ticket holder area will be introduced on a small area of car parking land lying between Cornwallis Street, South Terrace
- (2) The remainder of the car park will be designated as a short stay car park with a maximum waiting limit of four hours.

The proposal was published in The London Gazette on 3rd March 2000 (Issue No. 55780, Notice No. 497).

This Order will come into effect on 8th May 2000.

THE A43 TRUNK ROAD (SYRESHAM, NORTHAMPTONSHIRE) (50 MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2000

The Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions hereby gives notice that he has made an Order, under sections 84 (1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, on a length of the A43 Trunk Road at Syresham in Northamptonshire.

The effect of the Order, which will come into force on 16th May 2000, will be to impose a 50 miles per hour speed limit on the length of the A43 between points 280 metres west of its junction with B4525 Banbury Lane and 270 metres east of its junction with Abbey Road, a distance of 1,270 metres.
