Well Bank/Crown Bank (south-east side):

From a point 14 metres west of the centre line of its junction with Church Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 34 metres to a point 20 metres north of the centre line of its junction with Church Street. Well Bank/Crown Bank (north-west side)
