STOPPING-UP OF HIGHWAY AT SANDSIDE,
SCARBOROUGH

Notice is given that the Scarborough Borough Council (the Council) as agent for the North Yorkshire County Council, the Highway Authority, intend to apply to the Magistrates Court sitting at the Law Courts, Northway, Scarborough, at 10 a.m., on Wednesday, 26th July 2000, for an Order that an area of highway forming part of the footway of Sandside, Scarborough, in the ownership of the Council be stopped up, pursuant to section 116, Highways Act 1980, on the grounds that it is unnecessary.

The effect of the Order is shown in a plan available for inspection at the Town Hall, St. Nicholas Street, Scarborough, free of charge, during normal office hours and will mean that the said area will be released from the highway and vest in the Council, being the adjoining owner, free from any rights of the public to pass and repass thereon. In exchange the Council intend to dedicate as highway a neighbouring piece of land in its ownership shown in the said plan.

 - (ii) Clarendon Street, Ince, whole length, from its westerly end with Warrington Road to its easterly end with Ainscow Street, a distance of approximately 45 metres.
 - (iii) Walmesley Street, Ince, whole length, from its westerly end with Warrington Road to its easterly end with Ainscow Street, a distance of approximately 40 metres.
 - (iv) Margaret Street, Ince, whole length, from its south-westerly end with Warrington Road to its north-easterly end with Ainscow Street, a distance of approximately 45 metres.
 - (v) Stafford Street, Ince, whole length, from its south-westerly end with Warrington Road to its north-easterly end with Ainscow Street, a distance of approximately 46 metres.

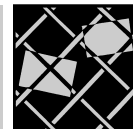

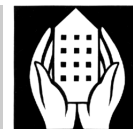
