TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions, hereby gives notice that he has made an Order, under section 247 of the above Act, entitled "The Stopping-up of Highways (County of Nottinghamshire) (No. 3) Order 2000", authorising the stopping-up of a length of highway at Water Lane, Mansfield, Nottinghamshire, from the junction with Abbott Road in a westerly direction, for a maximum length of 146 metres.

The stopping-up is authorised only in order to enable the development described in the Schedule to this notice to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted to Hallam Land Management Ltd, by Mansfield District Council on 29th November 1999, under Ref. 1999/11938/0649/OP.

The Order requires the provision of a new highway and the improvement of existing highway by Hallam Land Management Ltd, maintainable at public expense, and for which the highway authority is to be the Nottinghamshire County Council.
