THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONDON TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Mayor and Commonalty and Citizens of the City of London hereby gives notice that it has made an Order, entitled "The Stopping-up of Highways (City of London) (No. 2) Order 2000", under section 247 of the above Act, authorising the stopping-up of Post Office Court and a strip of Lombard Street, London E.C.3.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

The Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order, under section 248 of the above Act, which will authorise the stopping-up of two areas of highway at The Hythe Road, near Marchwood, Hampshire.

The proposed Order will not be made unless planning permission for the development described in the Schedule to this notice is granted, and in that event the stopping-up will be authorised only in order to enable the development to be carried out in accordance with that planning permission. Planning permission for that development was applied for to New Forest District Council on 2nd October 2000, under Ref. 00070243.
