#### THE EALING (PRESCRIBED ROUTES) (NO. 42) TRAFFIC ORDER 2000

#### THE EALING (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (SPECIAL PARKING AREA) (AMENDMENT NO. 99) ORDER 2000

#### THE EALING (BUS STOP CLEARWAY) (AMENDMENT NO. 8) TRAFFIC ORDER 2000

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Ealing, hereinafter called the Council, on 15th November 2000, made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

The general effect of the prescribed routes Order will be to:

- prohibit all vehicles, except buses, from proceeding in that length of South Parade specified in Schedule 1 to this notice;
- prohibit all vehicles from entering the north-west to south to south-east arm of South Parade between the eastern side of the small triangular island site and a point opposite the easternmost wall of The Duke of Sussex public house.

The general effect of the Waiting and Loading Restriction Order will be to further amend the Ealing (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Special Parking Area) (No. 1) Order 1994 so as to impose waiting restrictions, operative at any time, on the length of streets specified in Schedule 2 to this notice.

Details of exemptions for certain vehicles and persons are contained in the original Order of 1994.

The effect of the bus stop clearway Order will be to:

- designate a bus stop clearway, operative at any time, on the length of street specified in Schedule 3 to this notice;
- designate bus stop clearways, operative between 7 a.m. and midnight on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive, on the lengths of street specified in Schedule 4 to this notice;
- designate a bus stand, operative at any time, on the length of street specified in Schedule 5 to this notice.
