ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A64 TRUNK ROAD (COLTON) (PROHIBITION OF USE OF GAPS IN CENTRAL RESERVATION) ORDER

The Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions, hereby gives notice that he has made an Order, under sections 1(1) and 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, which comes into force on 25th November 2000.

The effect of the Order is as described in Issue No. 5642 of *The London Gazette* dated 21st May 1999, (Ref. 863).

A copy of the Order, and the relevant plan, have been deposited at the offices of North Yorkshire County Council, No. 4 Area Office, Fulford Lodge, Fulford, York YO10 4HW, where they can be inspected during normal working hours. They may also be seen at, or obtained by application to, the office of the Director, the Highways Agency, 8th Floor West, PO Box 206, City House, New Station Street, Leeds LS1 4UR.

Anyone wishing to question the validity of the Order, or any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers contained in the above Act; or any requirement of the above Act, or any Instrument made under it has not been complied with, may apply to the High Court, before 11th January 2001, to suspend or quash the Order, or any part of it.

THE BIRMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL (ST. MARTINS CIRCUS QUEENSWAY, CITY CENTRE) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2000
