TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK (DOCTORS' PARKING PLACES) TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER 2001/008

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Southwark on 1st February 2001, made the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985, and the Road Traffic Act 1991. This Order was formerly advertised as The London Borough of Southwark (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Bays) (Doctor Parking) Traffic Management Order 2000/032.

The general effect of the Order will be to:

(a) add to Southwark (Doctors' Parking Places) Order 1974/491, by designating parking places in Camberwell Green and D'Eynsford Road, specifically for vehicles displaying a valid permit issued by the London Borough of Southwark on application being made by legally qualified medical practitioners.

A copy of the Order (which will come into operation for the purposes of the placing of traffic signs on 31st January 2001, and for all other purposes on 1st February 2001) plus plans which indicate the lengths of road to which the Order relate can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of 21 days from the date on which the Orders were made in the Council Offices, Chiltern House, Portland Street, London SE17 2ES.

Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 21 days of the date on which this Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

PROPOSED STOPPING-UP OF SILVER HOWE CLOSE, KENDAL

The Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 247 of the above Act, which will authorise the stopping-up of a footway at Silver Howe Close, Kendal.

If the Order is made, the stopping-up will be authorised only in order to enable the development described in the schedule to this notice to be carried out in accordance with the planning permissions granted to Mr. R. Teasdale, by South Lakeland District Council, on 9th June 2000 and 6th November 2000 under references 5/00/0791 and 5/00/2300 respectively.

STOPPING-UP OF HIGHWAYS AT ST. NICHOLAS PLACE, PIER HEAD, LIVERPOOL

The Secretary of State for the Environment, Transport and the Regions, following the holding of a public inquiry gives notice that on the application of Robert Turley Associates Limited, he has made an Order under section 247 of the above Act entitled "The Stopping-Up of Highways (City of Liverpool) (No. 1) Order 2001", authorising stopping-up of a highway at St. Nicholas Place. The proposed Order will also authorise the stopping-up of the footbridge and its re-dedication as a replacement right of way at the Pier Head, Liverpool.
