##### THE GUILDFORD OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES (CONSOLIDATION AND AMENDMENT) ORDER 1996 (AS AMENDED)

##### THE GUILDFORD (FARNHAM ROAD MULTI-STOREY/YORK ROAD MULTI-STOREY/TUNSGATE/CASTLE CAR PARKS) OFF STREET PARKING PLACES ORDERS 1989/1992/1995/2000

Notice is hereby given that Guildford Borough Council in exercise of its powers, under section 35C of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and of all other enabling powers, has approved a variation in certain parking tariffs currently contained in the:

- (1) Guildford Off Street Parking Places (Consolidation and Amendment) Order 1996 (as amended)
- (2) Guildford (Farnham Road Multi-Storey Car Park) (Off Street Parking Places) Order 1989 (as amended)
- (3) Guildford (York Road Multi-Storey Car Park) (Off Street Parking Places) Order 1992 (as amended)

(4) Guildford (Tunsgate Car Park) (Off Street Parking Places) Order 1995 (as amended)

(5) Guildford (Castle Car Park) (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2000

Details of the changes are as follows:

(a) the introduction of a new charge of £0.50 per visit between the hours of 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Sundays at the following car parks:
