- 3. This programme of works will commence on or within one month of 1st June 2001.
- 4. The works notified will include full width carriageway resurfacing. Subject to the exemptions in the Act and regulations under it, no street works may be executed for a period of 12 months from completion of the works described in paragraph 4 without of the said Highway Authority, which shall not be unreasonably withheld.
