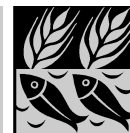

THE CRICHEL DOWN RULES, TRACE OF FORMER OWNERS

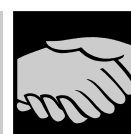

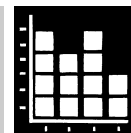
