RESTORATION OF PROHIBITED MOVEMENTS FOR VEHICLES AT CANNON STREET/QUEEN STREET JUNCTION

Notice is hereby given that the Common Council of the City of London propose to make an Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order would be in conjunction with a junction improvement scheme to:

- (a) amend the London Traffic (Prescribed Routes) (City of London) Regulations 1964, so as to restore the right turn by vehicles from Cannon Street into Queen Street, north of Cannon Street, and the right turn by vehicles from Queen Street into Cannon Street, east of Queen Street;
- (b) revoke the City of London (Prescribed Routes) Traffic Order 1968, so as to restore the left turn by vehicles from Cannon Street into Queen Street and the left turn from Queen Street, north of Cannon Street, into Cannon Street.

A copy of the proposed Order, of the above-mentioned regulations and Order, of the Common Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Order and of a plan showing the affected streets can be inspected, during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays within a period of 21 days from the date on which this notice was published, in The Town Clerk's Department, Guildhall, London E.C.2.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO VARY A LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Take notice that Lower Reule Farm Limited, of Willow End, Cowley, Gnosall, Stafford, is applying to the Environment Agency to vary licence serial number 3/28/3/135/S, to abstract water from an unnamed tributary of the Church Eaton Brook between National Grid Ref. SJ 843 196 and SJ 843 185 at Brookfields Farm and Lower Reule Farm, Gnosall.

The variation being applied for is to amend the flow restriction condition from 172.8 Megalitres per day on the River Sow, at Milford to 56.2 Megalitres per day on the River Penk at Penkridge.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO VARY A LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Take notice that C W Dobbs & Son Ltd, of Home Farm, Hollands Chase, West Pinchbeck, Spalding PE11 3QD, is applying to the Environment Agency to vary licence serial number 5/31/14/S/117, which authorises the irrigation of land at Monks House Farm, Spalding, using water abstracted from the Vernatts Drain, Deeping Fen at Grid Ref. TF 222 227.

The variation being applied for is as follows:

1. to add additional land situated at Mill Green House Farm;
2. to add additional abstraction points between TF 226 230 and TF 239 241.

There will be no change to the authorised quantity of water abstracted.
