THE CROYDON (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (AMENDMENT NO 9) TRAFFIC ORDER 2001

1. Notice is hereby given that the London Borough of Croydon on 9 July 2001 made the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act, 1985.
2. The general effect of the Order would be to further amend the Croydon (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 2000 so that waiting by vehicles would be prohibited at any time throughout the week in those lengths of streets as specified in the Schedule to this notice.
3. The prohibition referred to in paragraph 2 above will not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in certain circumstances, eg the picking up or setting down of passengers; the carrying out of statutory powers or duties; the taking in of petrol, etc, from roadside petrol stations; to licensed street traders etc. The usual exemption relating to vehicles displaying a disabled person's "Badge" will apply.
4. A copy of the Order, which will come into operation on 16 July 2001, of the Croydon (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order, 2000 (and of any Order which has previously amended that Order) can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, until the end of six weeks from the date on which the Order was made at the Enquiry Counter, "One Stop" Facility, Taberner House, Park Lane, Croydon, Surrey.
5. Copies of the Order may be obtained from the Parking and Technical Services Section of the Public Services and Works Department, Room 4.06, Municipal Offices, Fell Road, Croydon.
6. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder have not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks of the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

- Greenside Road*, from the south-eastern kerblines of Sutherland Road south-eastward for a distance of 25.50 metres, measured on the north side.
- Midhurst Avenue*, from the eastern kerblines of Sutherland Road to the south-western boundary of No 66 Midhurst Avenue.
- Pemdevon Road*, from the south-eastern kerblines of Sutherland Road south-eastward for a distance of 10 metres.
