

Animal Health

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 1, and 34(7) of the Animal Health Act 1981 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, makes the following Order:

SI 2001 No 1242

This Order may be cited as the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Ascertainment of Value) (No 4) Order 2001 and came into force on 28 March 2001. This Order, which extends to England, revokes the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Ascertainment of Value) (No 3) Order 2001 (SI 2001/1155) and sets out the requirements for the valuation of animals slaughtered or liable to be slaughtered as a result of Foot-and-Mouth Disease. It adds various categories of calves to the Schedule. A Regulatory Impact Assessment has not been prepared. 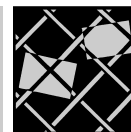
SCHEDULE 2

PART 1

FORM OF APPLICATION FOR A PRIVATE ELECTRICITY SUPPLY LICENCE OR EXTENSION

1. Full name of applicant: Npower Yorkshire Limited.
2. Address of the applicant, or in the case of a body corporate, the registered or principal office: Trigonos, Windmill Hill Business Park, Whitehill Way, Swindon, Wiltshire SN5 6PB.
3. Where the applicant is a company, the full names of the current Directors and the company's registered number: Registered number is 3937808, Current Directors: Brian Morrison Count, Steve Fletcher, Mike Bowden is Company Secretary.
4. Where a holding of 20 per cent or more of the shares of an applicant is held by a body corporate or partnership or an unincorporated association carrying on a trade or business with or without a view to profit, the name(s) and address(es) of the holder(s) of such shares shall be provided. 100 per cent share capital owned by Innogy plc of above address.

A description of the system of electric lines and electrical plant by means of which the applicant intends to supply electricity, indicating which plant and lines are to be constructed and which are existing plant and lines, and further identifying any parts of that system which will not be owned by or otherwise in the possession of the applicant: Lines and plant owned by National Grid PLC, Scottish Power, Scottish Hydro-electric and lines owned by any Public Electricity Supplier in England and Wales.
8. A statement of the extent (if any) to which the applicant considers it necessary for powers under Schedule 3 (compulsory acquisition of land etc) and under Schedule 4 (other powers etc) to the Act to be given through the licence for which he is applying: Not required.
9. Details of any licences held, applied for or being applied for by the applicant in respect of the generation, transmission or supply of electricity: None. (486)
