##### LIVESEY PLACE, PECKHAM PARK ROAD, WILLOWBROOK ROAD, BRABOURN GROVE AND HOLLYDALE ROAD NOTICE OF TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

##### NOTICE OF (PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS) TRAFFIC ORDER 2001/100

1. The Council of the London Borough of Southwark proposes to introduce a Pedestrian Crossing as detailed below under section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and of all other powers thereunto.

The controlled area shall cover a distance of 18.606 metres in a south-western direction from the limits of the crossing.
