NEW ROADS AND STREET WORKS ACT 1991, SECTION 58

NOTICE OF SUBSTANTIAL ROAD WORKS FOR ROAD PURPOSES

1. Three months' advance notice is hereby given that Derbyshire County Council intends to carry out substantial works for road purposes.
 2. The streets in which these works will take place are Mill Lane (Phase 1), Condor.
 3. Works are expected to affect the carriageway between Mill Lane (all) from the junction with High Street.
 4. Works are expected to commence on 28 July 2002.
 5. The works notified will include carriageway resurfacing.
 6. Subject to the exemptions in the Act and regulations under it, no street works may be executed for a period of 12 months from the completion of the works described in paragraph 5 without the consent of the said Highway Authority, which shall not be unreasonably withheld.

NOTICE OF SUBSTANTIAL ROAD WORKS

1. Three months' advance notice is hereby given that the London Borough of Tower Hamlets intends to carry out substantial road works.
2. The location in which these works are to take place is Tower Hill, London E1 at its junction with Tower Bridge Northern Approach, Mansell Street and East Smithfield.
3. Work is expected to commence on 9 June 2002.
4. (a) The area of work shall be defined as Mansell Street south of Royal Mint Street, Tower Hill south of Shorter Street, Tower Bridge Approach at North Portal and East Smithfield 100 metres east of junction.
- (b) The works notified will include reconstruction of islands, provision of new traffic signals, full reconstruction of the existing carriageway, plus the repaving of all surrounding footways.
5. Subject to the exemption in the Act and regulations under it, no street works may be executed for a period of 12 months from completion of the works described in paragraph 5 without the consent of the said Highway Authority, which shall not be unreasonably withheld.

1. Three months' advance notice is hereby given that the London Borough of Tower Hamlets intends to carry out substantial road works.
2. The streets in which these works will take place are Watney Street, Tarling Street, Bigland Street, Dunch Street, Morris Street and Chapman Street, London E1.
