##### LIMITED TIME GOODS VEHICLE LOADING BAYS

##### ADDISON ROAD, SOUTH NORWOOD AND WORTLEY ROAD, THORNTON HEATH

1. Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Croydon propose to make the Croydon (Goods Vehicles) (Free Parking Places) (No 1) Traffic Order 2002 (Amendment No Z73) Order 2002 under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and the Road Traffic Act 1991.

2. The general effect of the Order will be:

(a) to designate free parking places in Addison Road, South Norwood and Wortley Road, Thornton Heath as specified in the Schedule to this notice;

(b) to provide that the parking place would be in operation between the hours of 7.00 am and 7.00 pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive;
