ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A420 TRUNK ROAD (FYFIELD TO TUBNEY WOOD, OXFORDSHIRE) (50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 200

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make the above-mentioned Order under section 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, on the A420 Trunk Road, in the district of Vale of White Horse, in the county of Oxfordshire.

The effect of the Order would be to impose a 50 mph speed limit on a length of the A420 Trunk Road, from a point 318 metres west of its junction with the road to Fyfield, known as Digging Lane to a point 1,208 metres east of its junction with the unnamed road to Tubney, (bounded to the south-west by the property known as North Lodge), a distance of 2,932 metres.

THE A420 TRUNK ROAD (BESSELS LEIGH SCHOOL TO CUMNOR) (50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 200

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make the above-mentioned Order under section 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, on the A420 Trunk Road in the district of Vale of White Horse in the county of Oxfordshire. The effect of the Order would be to impose a 50 mph speed limit on a length of the A420 Trunk Road from a point 988 metres south-west of its junction with Besselsleigh Road to a point 1,500 metres north of its junction with Besselsleigh Road; a distance of 2,488 metres.

THE BEXLEY (BUS LANE) AND (BUS ONLY ROUTES) TRAFFIC ORDER 2002

THE BEXLEY (ERITH TOWN CENTRE) (PRESCRIBED ROUTES) TRAFFIC ORDER 2002

1. Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Bexley, on 2 December 2002, made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985.

2. The general effect of the Bexley (Bus Lane) and (Bus Only Routes) Traffic Order 2002, which will come into operation on 9 December 2002, will be to:

(a) consolidate and reproduce all the Bexley Bus Lane Traffic Orders and those parts of various Prescribed Routes Traffic Orders which relates to buses, without any changes to the restrictions imposed by those Orders sent with provisions to facilitate enforcement using Camera Technology.

(b) revoke the Traffic Orders (or parts of Orders) listed in the Schedule to this notice.

3. The general effect of the Bexley (Erith Town Centre) (Prescribed Routes) Traffic Order 2002, would be to re-enact the provisions of the Bexley (Prescribed Routes) (No 2) Order 1998 and the Bexley (Prescribed Routes) (No 4) Traffic Order 1998, other than those relating to bus lanes and bus only routes.
