THE A12 TRUNK ROAD (BRENTWOOD BYPASS, ESSEX) (DE-RESTRICTION) ORDER 200

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC PROHIBITIONS

THE AVENUE, UNION STREET, RAVENSCROFT PARK AND BLENHEIM ROAD, BARNET

The Barnet London Borough Council hereby give notice that owing to the need to carry out water main works, they intend to make an Order which will introduce temporary prohibitions and restrictions in Union Street, The Avenue, Ravenscroft Park and Blenheim Road, Barnet. The traffic arrangements will be as follows:

(a) Union Street and The Avenue will be closed at their junctions with Wood Street until the said works have been completed.

(b) Parking and loading will be prohibited At Any Time on the east side of Blenheim Road from its junction with Wood Street to its junction with Ravenscroft Park.

The prohibitions will commence on Monday 13 January 2003 at 8.00 am and are expected to last 2 weeks. In any event, subject to the provision of section 15(5), the Order will remain in effect until the works are completed.

Nothing in the above paragraphs shall apply to anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a Police Constable or a Traffic Warden in uniform.

PROPOSED WAITING RESTRICTIONS—ALBERT ROAD, ALFRISTON AVENUE, DACRE ROAD, ELDON PARK, MARLPIT LANE, REDDOWN ROAD, SALCOT CRESCENT, SOUTHLANDS CLOSE AND STONECROFT WAY

1. Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Croydon propose to make the Croydon (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No C79) Traffic Order 2003 under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act, 1985.

2. The general effect of the Order would be to further amend the Croydon (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 2001 so that waiting by vehicles, otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle, would be prohibited at any time throughout the week in those lengths of streets specified in the Schedule to this notice.

The prohibition referred to in paragraph 2 above would not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in certain circumstances, eg, the picking up or setting down of passengers; the carrying out of statutory powers or duties; the taking in of petrol, etc, from roadside petrol stations; to licensed street traders, etc. The usual exemption relating to vehicles displaying a disabled person's "Badge" will apply.

The proposed Order is intended to introduce waiting restrictions "At any time" throughout the week in Albert Road, Alfriston Avenue, Dacre Road, Eldon Park, Marlpit Lane, Reddown Road, Salcot Crescent, Southlands Close and Stonecroft Way. The restrictions proposed for Dacre Road and Stonecroft Way would prevent obstructive junction parking and difficulty experienced by larger vehicles negotiating the bend. The existing restrictions covering the junction of Marlpit Lane and Reddown Road are insufficient to prevent Sunday and evening parking, especially when there are events held at the Memorial Ground. Waiting restrictions are proposed at the northern end of Southlands Close to improve visibility sight lines for drivers leaving an off-street car park. The junction of Albert Road and Eldon Park is subject to obstructive parking due to its close proximity to the South Norwood Controlled Parking Zone. "At any time" waiting restrictions would alleviate problems for pedestrians and vehicles negotiating the junction. Evening parking is creating a problem for buses turning right from Montacute Road into Salcot Crescent and with the introduction of larger buses on this route more stringent restrictions are required.

LONDON BUS PRIORITY AND CYCLE NETWORK—BOSTON MANOR ROAD, BRENTFORD

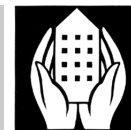
