#### Road Traffic Acts

##### *National Assembly for Wales*

**THE TRUNK ROADS A5/A55 (VARIOUS LAY-BYS, CLWYD) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 1986 (VARIATION) ORDER 2003**

Notice is hereby given that the Minister for Environment, acting on behalf of the National Assembly for Wales, proposes to make an Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2), 4(2) and 124 of, and paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the proposed Order will be to vary the Trunk Roads A5/A55 (Various Lay-Bys, Clwyd) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1993 by removing the waiting restriction on the Trout Farm access road as it is proposed to construct a two way cycleway/footway over that length.

During a period of 21 days from 4 March 2003, a copy of the proposed Order, together with a plan and a statement of reasons for the making of the Order, may be inspected, free of charge, during normal opening hours at Denbighshire County Council Offices, Caledfryn, Smithfield
