### THE BARNET (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) (SPECIAL PARKING AREA) (1997, NO 53) (AMENDMENT NO ) TRAFFIC ORDER 2003

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Barnet propose to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation 1984, and all other enabling powers.

This Order amends existing waiting restrictions and introduces new waiting restrictions in various roads as shown in the Schedules below. These waiting restrictions will ensure the free passage of vehicles, protect vehicle accesses and maintain junction safety.
