THE A6 TRUNK ROAD (KIBWORTH, LEICESTERSHIRE) (RESTRICTION AND 40 MILES PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2003

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under sections 82(2), 83(1) and 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the A6 Trunk Road at Kibworth in the County of Leicestershire.

The effect of the Order, which comes into force on 27 May 2003, will be to impose:

- (a) a 30 miles per hour speed limit on the A6 Trunk Road between points 171 metres north and 265 metres north of the centreline of its junction with Wistow Road, and
 (b) a 40 miles per hour speed limit on the A6 Trunk Road between points 265 metres north and 505 metres north of the centreline of its junction with Wistow Road.

1.  (d) specify, in respect of the parking places, that disabled persons' vehicles displaying in the relevant position a disabled persons' badge issued by any local authority under the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975, 1982 or 2000 as amended, may be left therein; and
