THE TRUNK ROADS A5/A55 (VARIOUS LAY-BYS, CLWYD) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 1986 (VARIATION) ORDER 2003

Notice is hereby given that the Minister for Economic Development and
Transport, acting on behalf of the National Assembly for Wales has
made an Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2), 4(2) and 124 of, and
paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984,
which comes into force on 6 June 2003.

The effect of the Order will be to vary the Trunk Roads A5/A55
(Various Lay-Bys, Clwyd) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1986 by
removing the waiting restriction on the Trout Farm access road as it is
proposed to construct a two-way cycleway/footway over that length.
