CTRL—KINGS CROSS DEVELOPMENT

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Camden propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and the Road Traffic Act 1991.

The general nature and effect of the Orders will be to introduce double yellow line "at any time" waiting restrictions in all the area of roads currently forming part of the construction site for the Channel Tunnel Rail Link works in and around Kings Cross Station.

The roads affected include: Goodsway; Camley Street; Granary Street; Pancras Road (North and South Arm); Cheney Road; Midland Road; Battle Bridge Road; Brill Place; Chenies Place; Purchese Street and York Way (west side).

The Order will also revise the parking layout to revoke existing meter/ "pay & display", resident and taxi parking places and I motorcycle in Cheney Road. The proposal will adjust the Priority (Red) Route boundary on Pancras Road.

CYCLE LANES

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Camden propose to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and the Road Traffic Act 1991.

The general nature and effect of the Order will be:

- 1. To introduce a new two-way with-flow and contra-flow segregated cycle lane in Tavistock Place (north side, between the eastern kerbline of Tavistock Square and a point 21 metres east of the eastern kerbline of Marchmont Street).
- 2. The cycle lanes will prohibit all vehicles, except for pedal cycles, from entering, proceeding or waiting within those lanes. Cycle lanes will allow for cyclists to travel either in a with-flow or contra-flow direction.

CYCLE LANES

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Camden propose to make the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and the Road Traffic Act 1991.

The general nature and effect of the Orders will be:

- 1. To introduce a new contra-flow segregated cycle lane in Bury Place (south-west side, between Great Russell Street and Bloomsbury Way).
- 2. To introduce a new with-flow part segregated, part two-way cycle lane in Bury Place (south-west side, between Great Russell Street and Bloomsbury Way).
- 3. To introduce a new with-flow cycle lane in Bury Place, south-west side, which lies between 3.75 metres south-east and a point 13 metres south-east of the kerbline of Bloomsbury Way.
- 4. The cycle lanes will prohibit all vehicles, except for pedal cycles from entering, proceeding or waiting within those lanes. Cycle lanes will allow for cyclists to travel either in a with-flow or contra-flow direction, with also a section of two-way-flow.
- 5. The proposal will also continue to prescribe that all vehicles travelling south-eastward in Bury Place on reaching its junction with Bloomsbury Way should turn left. All vehicles travelling northwestward in Bury Place on reaching its junction with Bloomsbury Way should turn right. Except for pedal cycles which may continue ahead into Bury Place.
- 6. To revoke all the existing pay & display and resident parking places on the south-west side and re-locate a resident parking place in that part of Bury Place, between Great Russell Street and Bloomsbury Way.
- 7. To convert 10 existing pay & display parking spaces in Little Russell Street into resident parking places.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 23 PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE PELICAN CROSSING AT THE NORTH-WESTERN CORNER OF RUSSELL SQUARE

The Council of the London Borough of Camden, having consulted the Metropolitan Police and the Secretary of State for Transport, hereby gives notice that it proposes:

To amend at the existing pelican crossing at the north-western corner of Russell Square, south of the junction with Thornhaugh Street, by extending the zig-zag markings by 8 metres northwards at the east side of the road, to a total length of 12 metres. A part of the taxi Rank No 4938, 13.5 metres, will be relocated to the north-western corner of the western arm of Russell Square from its eastern side. Therefore, new location of the taxi stand will be between the end of the zig-zag markings and the uncontrolled pedestrian crossing. There will be double yellow lines within the taxi bay.
