(i) residents' permits, visitors' vouchers up to maximum of 6 hours per day, all day visitors' vouchers, hired vehicle residents' permits and hired vehicles residents' vouchers, permits to park, teachers' permits, business permits and up to three business vouchers (maximum parking period of 3 hours), business permits (unlimited stay) and match day permits would be valid for use in residents' parking places, shared-use (all permits and pay and display) parking places and shared-use (business permits and pay and display) parking places; and

(a) residents' permits, £95 per year or a reduced rate of £75 per year for a vehicle that is fuel cell powered, gas powered, electric powered or hybrid system powered or with an engine capacity of 1399 cc or less or £35 per year for a motorcycle;

(b) (residents') visitor vouchers; 60p per hour up to a maximum of 6 hours per day with half hour and 3 hour duration vouchers;

(c) all day visitors' vouchers; £6 per voucher with a limit of 5 vouchers per year per resident;

(d) hired vehicles residents' permits; £10 per year for use with hired vehicles residents' vouchers;

(e) hired vehicles residents' vouchers; 40p per hour;

(f) permits to park; £9 per day (only available for vehicles required for carrying out building and maintenance work on premises adjacent to any parking place);

(g) all day annual business permits; £560 per year;

(h) business permits; £10 per year for use with business vouchers;
