ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

THE M62 MOTORWAY (JUNCTION 33, FERRYBRIDGE) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2003 (AMENDMENT)

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Transport has made an Order on the M62 Motorway in the district of Wakefield to enable construction of the new Longbull Hill Bridge to be carried out in safety. This Order will come into force on Sunday 18 January 2004, and will remain in force until the works have been completed.

The effect of this Amendment Order will be to amend the existing temporary Order for the above works (which came into force on 26 March 2003) by extending the temporary 50 miles per hour speed limit by 600 metres westwards, and the hardshoulder running and the restriction of vehicles wider than 6' 6" to certain lanes by 4,100 metres westwards. This Order also gives the Agents the option of extending the carriageway closures and contraflow by 4,100 metres westwards if required. Traffic signs will indicate the extent of the restriction and prohibitions (which will not apply to emergency vehicles).
