

3. The general effect of the "Prohibition of Stopping Outside Schools" Order would be to prohibit any vehicle stopping or remaining at rest between 8.15 am to 9.15 am and 2.30 pm to 4.30 pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, in Chadwick Road, the north-east side, from 17 metres south-east of Nos 1 and 3 Chadwick Road to 2 metres north-west of Nos 3 and 5 Chadwick Road.

4. The prohibition referred to in paragraph 3 above would not apply to:

- (a) any person causing or permitting a vehicle to stop or remain at rest;
- (i) if that person is obliged to do so in order to prevent an accident; or
- (ii) if that person is required to do by law;

(b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway by or on behalf of the Metropolitan Police.

5. The general effect of the "Waiting and Loading Restriction" Order would be further to amend the Brent (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1979, so that:

(a) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be prohibited at any time in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 2 to this notice;

(b) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be prohibited between 8.00 am and 6.30 pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, in the length of street specified in Schedule 3 to this notice;

(c) waiting by vehicles (otherwise than for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle) would be prohibited between 8.15 am and 9.15 am and between 2.30 pm and 4.30 pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, in the length of street specified in Schedule 4 to this notice;

(d) waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle for a period of more than 20 minutes in the same place would now be prohibited between:

- (i) 11.00 am and 6.30 pm throughout the week in the lengths of streets specified in Schedule 2 to this notice;
- (ii) 11.00 am and 6.30 pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, in the lengths of street specified in Schedule 3 to this notice;
- (iii) between 2.30 pm and 4.30 pm on Mondays to Fridays in the length of street specified in Schedule 4 to this notice;

(e) the sale or offer for sale of goods from a vehicle would be prohibited in the lengths of streets specified in Schedules 2, 3 and 4 unless there is in force a valid licence issued by the Brent Borough Council or the goods are immediately taken into or delivered at premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected;

(f) the use of any vehicle or of any animal or the wearing of fancy dress or other costume, wholly or mainly for the purpose of advertising, would be prohibited.

6. The prohibitions referred to in paragraph 5(a), (b), (c) and (d) above would not apply in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or in certain circumstances, eg, the picking up or setting down of passengers; the carrying out of statutory powers or duties; the taking in of petrol, etc, from roadside petrol stations; to licensed street traders, etc. The usual exemption relating to vehicles displaying a disabled person's "Blue/Orange Badge" would apply.

7. A copy of each of the proposed Orders, of maps of the relevant areas, of the Brent (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1979 (and of the Orders which have amended that Order), and of the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Orders can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, until the expiration of a period of 21 days from the date on which this notice is published at:

- (a) The One Stop Shop, Brent Town Hall, Forty Lane, Wembley, Middlesex HA9 9HX; and
- (b) The One Stop Shop, Brent House, 349-357 High Road, Wembley, Middlesex HA9 6BZ.

SCHEDULE 1

Free parking places (footway and carriageway) between 8.00 am and 6.30 pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive

Northview Crescent:

(a) the north-east and north-west sides;

- (i) from 10 metres north-west of Southview Avenue north-westward for 27.5 metres;
- (ii) from 40 metres north-west of Southview Avenue to 9 metres east of Nos 5/7 Northview Crescent;
- (iii) from 1 metre north-east of Nos 5 and 7 Northview Crescent north-eastward for 6 metres;
- (iv) from 1 metre south-west of Nos 5 and 7 Northview Crescent to Nos 4/6 Northview Crescent;
- (v) from 0.5 metre south-west of Nos 21 and 23 Northview Crescent south-westward for 5.5 metres;

(b) the south-east and south-west sides;

- (i) from 13 metres north-west of Southview Avenue north-westward for 25 metres;
- (ii) from 2 metres north-east of Nos 5 and 7 Northview Crescent south-westward for 20 metres.

SCHEDULE 2

Waiting restrictions (at any time)

Northview Crescent:

- (a) the north-east side, from Southview Avenue north-westward for 10 metres;
- (b) the south-west side, from Southview Avenue north-westward for 13 metres.

Southview Avenue, the north-west side, from 10 metres south-west of Northview Crescent to 10 metres north-east of Northview Crescent.

SCHEDULE 3

Waiting restrictions (between 8.00 am and 6.30 pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive)

Northview Crescent:

- (a) the north, north-east and north-west sides, from 10 metres north-west of Southview Avenue to its south-westernmost extremity;
- (b) the south, south-east and south-west sides, from 13 metres north-west of Southview Avenue to its south-westernmost extremity.

SCHEDULE 4

Waiting restrictions (between 8.15 am and 9.15 am and between 2.30 pm and 4.30 pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive)

Chadwick Road, the south-west side, from 13 metres south-east of Nos 1 and 3 Chadwick Road to 1 metre north-west of Nos 3 and 5 Chadwick Road.

THE BROMLEY (CONTROLLED PARKING) (ON STREET PLACES) ORDER 1998 (AMENDMENT NO 16) ORDER 2004

THE BROMLEY (WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTION) ORDER 2003 (AMENDMENT NO 9) ORDER 2004 (BURNT ASH LANE AREA)

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Bromley on 9 March 2004 made the above-mentioned Orders under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and the Road Traffic Act 1991, which will come into operation on 15 March 2004.

The effect of the Orders would be to regularise parking for road safety, and to give preference to residents, by introducing waiting restrictions and a permit parking scheme as specified in the Schedule to this notice. A copy of the Orders may be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays at the Bromley Civic Centre, Stockwell Close, Bromley, Kent until the expiration of a period of 6 weeks from the date of making the Orders.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant enabling Act or that any requirement of any such enabling Act or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with, may within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
