NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR CONSENT IN PURSUANCE OF SCHEDULE 10

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with Schedule 10 of the Water Resources Act 1991, as amended by the Environment Act 1995, that an application has been made to the Environment Agency by Lafarge Aggregates Limited for consent to discharge trade effluent. The application is for a consent to discharge up to a maximum of 6,000 cubic metres per day of uncontaminated groundwater from Block Fen Quarry at National Grid Ref TL 4294 8358 into an adjacent lake. The discharge will occur when the levels in the lake fall below a trigger level and is intended to protect the lake from the impact of dewatering in Block Fen Quarry. Block Fen Quarry is within the Fenland District Council and Cambridgeshire County Council areas.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO VARY A LICENCE TO ABSTRACT WATER

Take notice that Wm Bracey Ltd, of Billockby Hall, Billockby, Great Yarmouth, Norfolk, is applying to the Environment Agency to vary licence serial number 7/34/10/S/103, which authorises the abstraction of water from a reservoir connected to Ormesby Broad at National Grid Ref TG 4655 1695, at Martham, Norfolk.

The variation being applied for is to allow a change of use from frost protection to spray irrigation of agricultural crops from June to October of this year only, and to reduce the abstraction rates from 52,300 cubic metres per year to 30,000 cubic metres per year and from 5,230 cubic metres per day to 1,000 cubic metres per day.

A copy of the applications and any map, plans and other documents submitted with them may be inspected, free of charge, at all reasonable hours at Billockby Hall, Billockby, Great Yarmouth, Norfolk, between 4 June 2004 and 4 July 2004.
