#### SCHEDULE

1. The back alleyway between Stovin Street and West Terrace, from its junction with Cromwell Street in a northerly direction for a distance of 95 metres.
2. *Stovin Street*, from its junction with Cromwell Street in a northerly direction for a distance of 97 metres.
3. The back alleyway between Worsley Street and Stovin Street, from its junction with Cromwell Street in a northerly direction for a distance of 11 metres.
4. The back alleyway between Worsley Street and Stovin Street, from its junction with Trinity Crescent in a northerly direction for a distance of 41 metres.
5. *Worsley Street*, from its junction with Cromwell Street in a northerly direction for a distance of 11 metres.
6. The back alleyway on the eastern side of Cromwell Street, from its junction with the unnamed road linking Cromwell Street and the Market Place in a northerly direction for a distance of 19 metres.

9. The back alleyway between Hampden Street and Worsley Street, from a point 40 metres north of its junction with Cromwell Street in a northerly direction for a distance of 16 metres.
