ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A650 TRUNK ROAD (BINGLEY ROAD/HIRST LANE, SHIPLEY) (PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURNS)

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Transport has made an Order under sections 1(1) and 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the A650 Trunk Road in the district of Bradford in the county of West Yorkshire, which comes into force on Friday 18 February 2005.
