UNIVERSITIES OF OXFORD AND CAMBRIDGE ACT 1923

A Statute made by the Governing Body of the Gonville and Caius College, Cambridge, has been submitted for the approval of Her Majesty in Council, and notice of its having been submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act 1923.

The purpose of the amendment of Statutes 5(8), 46 and 49(1) is to enable the College to adopt a policy of Total Return in respect of its investments and expenditure; to bring up-to-date the statement of its corporate powers and fiduciary obligations in respect of its property; and to enable the Governing Body to make ordinances in respect of those powers and obligations. UNIVERSITIES OF OXFORD AND CAMBRIDGE ACT 1923

A Statute made by the Governing Body of the Downing College, Cambridge, has been submitted for the approval of Her Majesty in Council, and notice of its having been submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act 1923.

The purpose of the amendment of Statutes XXXVIII and XXXIX is to enable the college to adopt a Total Return policy for determining expenditure of its investments and to enable surplus amounts accruing to certain trusts to be applied for the general educational purposes of the College. (180)
